

## Radiologic Technology Licensure Disclosure

Upon earning an [Associate of Applied Science in Radiologic Technology](#), graduates will be eligible for and prepared to take the state registry examination administered by the [American Registry of Radiologic Technologists](#) (ARRT). Upon successfully passing the state registry exam, graduates may apply for licensure in Montana.

This disclosure indicates, as of May 19, 2022, the states that FVCC has determined through a reasonable, good faith effort that the radiologic technology program meets or does not meet the educational requirements for licensure or certification, or for which states FVCC has yet to make a determination.

If you are planning to pursue professional licensure or certification in a state other than Montana, we recommend that you contact the appropriate licensing board in that state to seek information and guidance regarding licensure or certification requirements before beginning an academic program.
